GENERAL INFO

Where do I drop-off and pick-up my camper?

- Drop-off and pick-up occurs in the parking lot across the street from main camp. You will see a table on the sidewalk where check-in occurs every morning from 8:30am- 9am and check-out occurs every afternoon from 4pm-4:30pm. Please have I.D. ready upon pick-up.

What do I do if I have to check-out my camper early from camp?

- Please check-in with your I.D. at the Marques front office (blue building located right as you enter) and office staff will inform Day Camp Director to assist in releasing your camper for the day.

What days does Day Camp swim?

- Monday- Wednesday we have free swim scheduled at the pool every morning right before lunch. On Friday's we have a beach party, so swim suits and a towel are encouraged to be packed if your camper would like to partake in the slip-n-slide, mini pool, and water games.

What are they filming at Camp Erdman?

- Camp Erdman is currently serving as a production set for the show Rescue HI- Surf, which is scheduled to be released September 1st on FOX Network. With the potential for the film crew to be on site, please be advised that check-in & check-out will still occur in the same parking lot, but the procedure may vary. 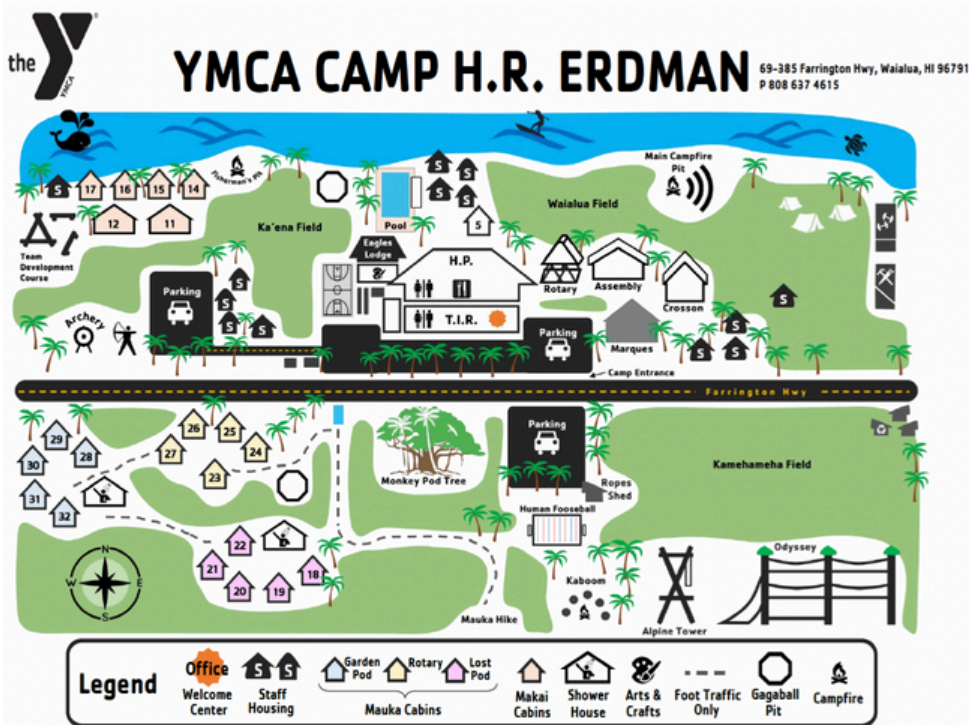
